



THERAPIST

DEFINITION: Under the supervision of the ElderVention Director of Behavioral Health, the Therapist responds to, documents, and reports on in-home referrals for clinical services.

I. MAJOR DUTIES

- A. Provide in-home counseling services to isolated seniors at risk for suicide, depression, anxiety, or other behavioral health issues; these services are provided county-wide
- B. Complete all client and service documentation in a timely manner, and maintain records of in-home activities;
- C. Make use of monthly supervision, if applicable, with ElderVention Director of Behavioral Health to improve service to clients and community
- D. Adhere to policy and procedures regarding in-home counseling services, make suggestions for process improvement as indicated
- E. Coordinate with other agency and community resources as needed

II. OTHER DUTIES

- A. Attend staff meetings
- B. Attend training on issues related to older adults and mental health
- C. Assist in developing/maintaining monthly, quarterly, and annual reports and in maintaining and expanding a computerized database
- D. Perform in a manner that is supportive to the cultural needs of the population(s) served by the program or service
- F. Perform other duties as assigned by the ElderVention Director of Behavioral Health

III. QUALIFICATIONS

Master's degree and Arizona licensure at LCSW level with at least one year of experience working with older adults, persons with disability, or other vulnerable populations; Knowledge of behavioral health agencies and community resources for older adults; Excellent documentation and computer skills; job requires county wide travel; must have reliable, insured transportation; have or able to obtain level one fingerprint clearance card. English/Spanish bilingual preferred.
